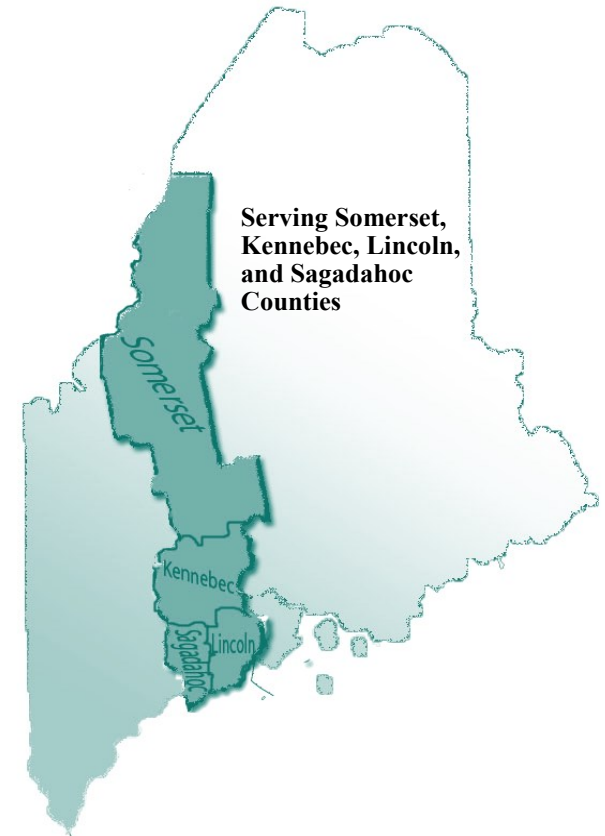

Energy & Housing Description of Programs

Home Repair Services

Provides assistance to make essential home repairs or improvements, such as roofing, siding or windows, or for health, safety and/or accessibility repairs. Income restrictions apply. (207) 859-1544 or email homeservices@kvcap.org

Energy Savings Program

Provides education and energy saving tools to HEAP eligible households to help reduce our energy burden. (207) 859-1500 or email energy@kvcap.org



CMP Pole Assistance Program

Provides a credit up to \$2,800 on the installation of electrical pole lines to a new residence. Income restrictions apply. (207) 859-1684 or email homeservices@kvcap.org

Weatherization

Provides a qualified Home Energy Auditor to complete an assessment on the home's energy use and loss. Approved contractors will install energy saving measures such as air sealing, insulation or weather stripping. (207) 859-1670 or email homeservices@kvcap.org

Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP)

Provides assistance to low-income homeowners and renters to help pay heating costs. HEAP is not intended to pay for all heating costs. Income restrictions apply.

If you qualify for HEAP, you may also qualify for these programs:

Low-Income Assistance Program (LIAP)

Provides help to low-income homeowners and renters with their electricity bills.

Emergency Crisis Intervention Program (ECIP)

Provides emergency heating assistance one time per heating season if you:

- Have a reading of 1/8 tank or less on standard 275 gallon oil tank
- Have a reading of 25% or less on a propane tank
- 3-day or less supply of firewood, wood pellets or other Home Energy types.

Central Heating Improvement Program (CHIP)

Provides evaluation, repair or replacement of non-working or condemned heating systems and heating oil tanks to homeowners. (207) 859-1684

Telephone Assistance Program (TAP)

Provides a monthly credit and/or assistance with connection of a telephone.
